Founded when King Rama I moved the city across the river from Thonburi in 1782, Bangkok is not a particularly ancient capital, but a city of dramatic contrasts. Stunning temples and mendicant monks share space with Western-style shopping complexes, cosmopolitan cafes, restaurants, and fast food outlets. Visitors flock to Bangkok to experience the unique beauty and mystique of its many temples and historical sites.

Visitors should not miss the Grand Palace, the official residence of the monarchs and still used for all Royal ceremonies. Also located on its grounds is the Temple of the Emerald Buddha, which is surrounded by walls more than a mile long, and contains some of the finest examples of Buddhist sculpture, architecture, painting, and decorative craft in the country.

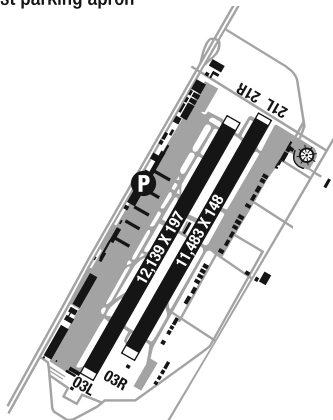

Driving directions

Directions to airport

Drive along Vibhavadee Rd. to the U-turn bridge (near police club). After the U-turn, drive straight to Laksi Junction (IT square). Turn left at Laksi Junction to Cheangwattana Rd. Along the way, you will see Big C Mall and TESCO on your right-hand side. Drive about 1.5 km, then turn right at traffic light. Drive straight when you see the S&P restaurant, then turn left, then make a right turn and drive about 100m to reach Andaman Aviation.

Directions to airport

Start at: "VTBS" Unknown road

1. Head north - 2.4 km
2. Take the ramp onto 31 - 1.5 km
3. Take the exit onto Bangkok-Chon Buri Partial toll road - 11.3 km
4. Continue on National Highway No. 7 toll road - 1.5 km
5. Continue on Bangkok-Chon Buri toll road - 0.3 km
6. Continue on Sirat Expressway toll road - 4.7 km
7. Continue on 3119 toll road - 16.9 km
8. Continue on 2nd State Expressway/Sirat Expressway toll road - 7.3 km
9. Continue on Bang Pa In-Pak Kret Expressway toll road - 1.2 km
10. Take the exit on the left toll road - 0.5 km
11. At the roundabout, take the first exit - 0.5 km
12. Turn left toward Bond St. - 0.5 km
13. Turn right toward Bond St. - 50 m
14. Turn right at Bond St. - 0.4 km
15. Turn left - 34 m
16. Turn right - 0.2 km
