Registry Access after Exit Day

This email communication is sent on behalf of the Department of Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy.

In a no deal scenario, in accordance with the European Commission's Notice to Stakeholders, you will lose access to any account and to holdings you have in the UK part of the Union Registry and the UK Kyoto Protocol Registry.

Therefore, Account Holders may wish to consider taking appropriate action to guarantee that they retain access to their allowances and units, for example, by moving these to an existing account in another part of the Union Registry or another country's Kyoto Protocol Registry. Clean Development Mechanism project participants who have previously received a letter of approval from the UK Designated National Authority should consider whether to reapply for a letter of approval from a different Designated National Authority.
