Subject: CORSIA: new ICAO documents and IATA AGM resolution

Dear colleagues,

We would like to inform you that the ICAO Council has approved the two following documents, which can now be downloaded from the ICAO website.

1. **CORSIA Aeroplane Operator to State Attributions**, which includes the list of aeroplane operators subject to CORSIA and their respective administrating authority. We would invite you to check that your airline has been correctly included in the list, under the appropriate State.

2. An initial **list of verification bodies** is also available in the ICAO Document *CORSIA Central Registry: Information and Data for Transparency*. Before contacting a verifier from the list, we would urge you to exercise due diligence as some of the verification bodies in the list might be accredited to perform verification for EU ETS only and not necessarily also for CORSIA. Therefore, please make sure to request that the verification bodies you contact can demonstrate that they have been accredited specifically for CORSIA by a national accreditation body.

We also wanted to let you know that the **75th IATA Annual General Meeting** adopted a resolution on CORSIA. The AGM resolution reiterates the strong support of IATA member airlines for CORSIA and their commitment to comply with it. It also urges ICAO member states to implement CORSIA as the single global market-based measure for international aviation and avoid implementing overlapping or duplicate measures such as unilateral carbon taxes.
