FAA Releases Notice about CORSIA Benchmarking Years 2019-2020

“Earlier this afternoon, the FAA posted a notice of the “CORSIA Monitoring, Reporting, and Verification Program” on its website. (The notice is available at: https://www.faa.gov/about/office_org/headquarters_offices/apl/research/environmental_policy). A Federal Register notice referring to the program website will be issued in the coming days.

This program implements the provisions of the International Civil Aviation Organization (“ICAO”) Carbon Offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation (“CORSIA”), and in particular the monitoring, reporting and verification requirements for 2019 & 2020. Under this voluntary program, U.S. air carriers, commercial, and general aviation operators can choose to undertake monitoring, reporting, and verification (“MRV”) of CO₂ emissions for international flights for the years 2019 and 2020.

As you are aware, specific inquiries regarding the CORSIA program can be made to the following email address: 9-AWA-CORSIA@faa.gov. Prior to today, we have received emissions monitoring plans, as well as other inquiries, and now that the program is live we will be actively responding to those inquiries. Please feel free to follow-up as needed, and we may also host a webex in the near future subject to interest.
